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TREE REMOVALS START

The Town will be commencing with the removal of trees along Innisfil Beach Road from the west side of St. John's Road to east of the 25th Side Road the week of June 1st.

The tree removals are being completed to clear the servicing corridor for the utilities such as Innisfil Hydro, Bell, Rogers Cable and Enbridge and for the reconstruction, widening and urbanization of Innisfil Beach Road.

Tree removals are scheduled to be completed by June 12th.

REMEMBER IT IS A CONSTRUCTION SITE

We would ask that everyone proceed through the site in a safe and orderly manner and that you obey all construction signage and flag persons. You may experience short delays as the contractor is completing certain works or maneuvering equipment around the construction site, we ask that you be patient and courteous at

UTILITY RELOCATES

As part of the Innisfil Beach Road reconstruction the existing overhead hydro and other utility cables are all being installed underground.

Starting early June contractors will be mobilizing to commence the installation of all the underground utility servicing. These works will be ongoing through September 2009.

The contractor will be working along the ditch line and therefore disruption to vehicular traffic should be minimized.

We would like to remind everyone that the area site is a construction zone and would ask parents to remind their children that it is not a play area. The contractor will make every attempt to make the safe site at the end of each work day. Your co-operation is appreciated.

BUSINESS ACCESS

Access to businesses within the construction zone will be maintained with some minor disruptions. The utility relocation works will involve excavation and installation of underground infrastructure. When construction crosses driveways there will be times when access will be restricted. Advanced notice of these interruptions will be provided to the owners.

URBANIZATION

SCHEDULE

The Town is in the process of issuing a tender for the urbanization and streetscaping works for the section of Innisfil Beach Road from St. John's Road east to the 25th Side Road.

More information will follow with respect to the timing of these works.

NOISE BYLAW EXEMPTION

Council has approved an exemption under the Noise Control Bylaw to the contractors completing the utility relocates. The exemption permits working on Saturdays from 9am to 4pm except if the weekend includes a Statutory Holiday.
